When adding color to new construction, the options and results are almost endless. Whether adding decorative accents, matching pre-existing structures, or a total color change, masonry stains offer more options with less maintenance.

Nawkaw Corporation was the first in North America to offer masonry staining as a service. Originally developed to help blend uncoordinated areas of masonry, the products were field tested and eventually developed for all porous masonry surfaces, such as brick, block, stucco, stone, tilt-up, precast, and EIFS.

Masonry stains can last for 25 years or more depending on which product is used. Look for a stain with a solid warranty and extensive field and laboratory testing. Ask for references to be sure you're working with a reputable company. There are two key factors when it comes to masonry staining. The first is having the right product. The second is hiring qualified professional applicators. Stain application is an art form much like faux painting. The stains can be applied with brushes, sponges and bags and even spray applications are available.

One of Nawkaw Corporation's recent precast staining projects is this four level Medical Center parking garage in Stockbridge, Ga. The parking garage houses space for 150 cars, and boasts 25,000 square feet of stained surface. The project was completed in 35 days with the assistance of swing stages and boom lifts and two Nawkaw crews. The concrete color was custom blended, using Nawkaw's proprietary product NWRT-91, to offer waterproofing characteristics as well. Nawkaw was specified to match the new construction surfaces to the new brick and mortar on the North Tower Expansion of the Medical Center.
