TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

The Nawkaw front office asked me for a recommendation when they heard how pleased we were with their work here at the University of New Hampshire. I am very happy to recommend them. Nawkaw solved a problem that developed as we scheduled masonry repairs at Morse Hall Science & Research Building. The structure plays a variety of scientific, social and cultural roles here at the University. Its appearance is important. Constructed in 1985, the exterior masonry details include granite sills, rose Gushwa-Calvert brick, and a highly contrasting forest green Belden brick which was out of production. The Belden people were very apologetic. It is their policy to match their brick whenever possible. A key ingredient just wasn't available. They recommended Nawkaw.

The results were great. Nawkaw field representatives mixed an additional red underlayment coat that they applied before the green. The repaired patches were indistinguishable from the original and were superior to the submittal that we had approved. They also applied their surface preparation to other bricks that we put into storage for future repairs. Nawkaw resolved an architectural dilemma for us. Their product exceeded our expectations and they went beyond the scope of our project to give us some future flexibility. We were very happy with them. If the appearance of masonry work is a concern, we encourage you to consider the surface application that Nawkaw offers.
